


- 1 LED

# 1.1 Buttons and control

Button	Control and function
ON	Switching on heater or ventilation
OFF	Switching off heater or ventilation
ON+OFF	<ul> <li>To change operating time, see operating instructions</li> <li>To change mode, see operating instructions</li> </ul>

# Switching on heater or ventilation\*

- ► Hold the hand-held transmitter with aerial vertical upward
- Press ON button until the LED comes on (approx. 1 second).


The Telestart receiver in the vehicle confirms that it has received the signal. See table for an overview of the feedback signals.




- the operating time has elapsed
- pressing the OFF button.

# Switching off heater or ventilation\*

- ► Hold the hand-held transmitter with aerial vertical upward.
- ▶ Press OFF button until the LED comes on (approx. 1 second).





\*: Optional

- If there are no special instructions on setting the vehicle heating system during parking heating operation the vehicle heating system must be set to "warm" before switching on the heater.
- Set the vehicle fan to the lowest setting (lower power consumption).

# Restoring factory setting

▶ Press the ON and OFF buttons simultaneously for at least 10 seconds.



Ignore colour changes in the LED.

Factory setting:

Mode: Heating

• Operating time: 30 minutes

# Disposal

Batteries and electronic devices are subject to the current versions of the European Directive 2006/66/EC or 2002/96/EC and must not be disposed of as household waste.



Dispose of packaging in corresponding recycling container in accordance with national regulations.

### ATTENTION

Improper use can cause the batteries to leak, overheat or explode. When handling the battery, follow all instructions and warnings that are supplied with or printed on the battery. The battery is not rechargeable therefore never attempt to charge the battery. Never short-circuit the battery. Never expose the battery to high heat. Do not transport the battery together with metal objects, e.g. necklaces or hair pins. The risk of the battery leaking is greatest when the battery is discharged. To avoid damage to the hand-held transmitter you should remove the battery when it is discharged or if the hand-held transmitter will not be used for a prolonged period. If liquid from a damaged battery comes in contact with clothing, the eyes or the skin, immediately flush the affected area with ample water. Dispose of the battery in accordance with locally applicable disposal regulations. Insulate the contacts with insulating tape. Keep new and used batteries out of the reach of children. Swallowing the battery can seriously damage your health. If a battery is swallowed immediately seek medical assistance. To extend the life of the battery, we recommend removing the battery from the hand-held transmitter if it is not to be used for a longer period of time.
